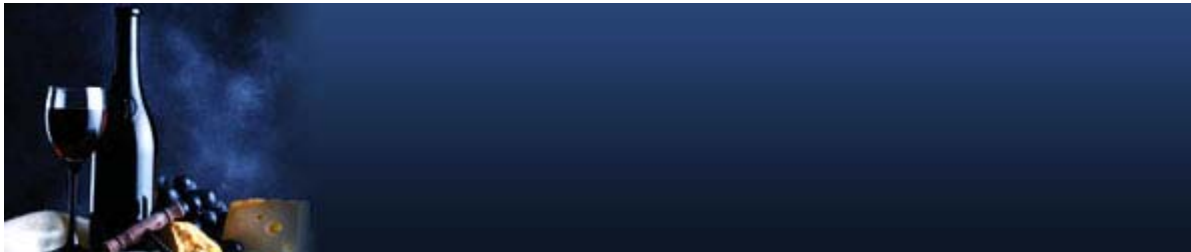

#### Tenuta Belguardo 2004 Tuscany - Cab, Cab Franc - Mazzei **\$ 23 gl**

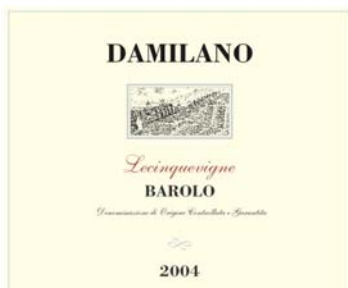


Made from Cabernet Sauvignon grapes with a small percentage of Sangiovese, this wine owes its big character and ample body to the extraordinary terroir in which it was born. It represents the first wine of the Estate.

#### Barolo 2004 - Damilano

**\$ 18 gl**

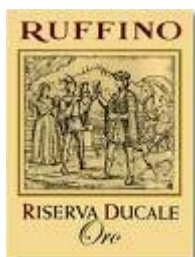


As the name suggests, Damilano's entry-level 2004 Barolo Lecinquevigne is made from five vineyards in the villages of Barolo, Castiglione Falletto and Monforte, and is aged in a combination of Slavonian and French oak. Tar, smoke, earthiness and black cherries emerge as this Barolo flows from the glass, showing unusually refined tannins for this bottling.

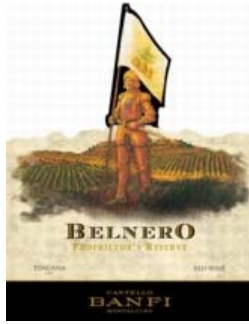
#### Chianti Classico Riserva Gold Label 2004 - Ruffino

**\$ 19 gl**



Ruby red in color, with garnet hues. Riserva Ducale Oro 2004 shows typical Tuscan characteristics with violet, cherry, and plum aromas and hints of white pepper. On the palate, this benchmark of fine Chianti Classico has a massive structure and an elegant, fruity core accented by rosemary and thyme. Full-bodied and well balanced, Riserva Ducale Oro's sweet, round tannins lead into a long finish with notes of violets, nutmeg, plums, and sweet tobacco.

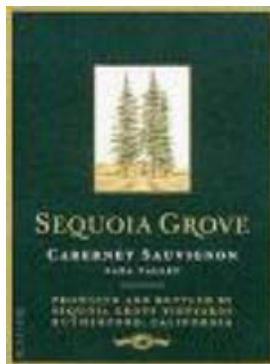

**BelnerO 2007 Montalcino - Sangiovese - Banfi****\$ 17 gl**

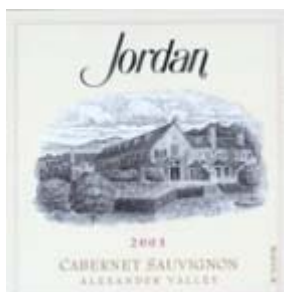
The 2007 vintage is characterized by an unusual balance between power and elegance. Deep red color, with mild garnet nuances. Very complex aroma on the nose, with spicy hints of tobacco and coffee, as well as fruity notes of blackberry jam. On the palate the structure is powerful, warm and soft, with a pleasant note of vanilla in the end. Enjoyable now yet endowed with great aging potential.

**Pinot Noir Jayson Sonoma Coast 2006 - Pahlmeyer****\$ 18 gl**

The 2006 Pahlmeyer Pinot Noir has a deep dark garnet color. In the glass the aromas open immediately, revealing layers of rich dense fruit, earth and sweet spices. The palate also offers layers upon layers of concentrated small berries, black raspberry and cherries, balanced with nicely integrated oak. This full bodied wine finishes with finesse and long lingering flavors

**Cabernet Rutherford Napa 2006 - Sequoia Grove****\$ 15 gl**

Inky red in color with an immediate hit of juicy, red cherries and fresh raspberries with background notes of red plum. Caramelized toast and cinnamon and clove aromas wave in the background. There is a hint of sage, cigar box, and that classic 'allspice' note. Well balanced palate with nice acid, round, subtle tannins and a lingering finish.

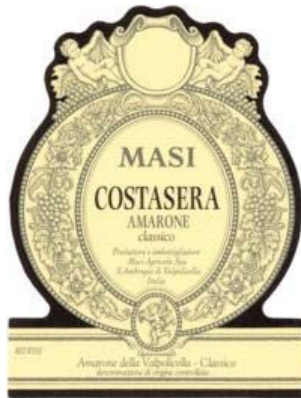
**Cabernet Alexander Valley Sonoma 2005 - Jordan****\$ 20 gl**

With concentrated aromas of cassis, cherry, cedar, red rose petal and tobacco, this wine's complexity continues through the flavors, which include red currant, cherry, blackberry and blueberry with a hint of vanilla from oak aging. Round tannins balance and support this medium-bodied wine's ripe fruit. This wine shows beautifully in its youth and will continue to age gracefully for a decade or more.

## Amarone Costasera 2005 - Masi - Veneto

**\$ 22 gl**



Deep ruby red color with violet tinges to the edges. Clean, very powerful and complex on the nose with good alcoholic backbone amid the sweet aromas of dried prunes and raisins. Soft and dry on the palate with typical baked cherry flavors mixed with hints of cocoa and cinnamon. Attractively long finishing and full-bodied with soft tannins. Amarone is a full-bodied wine for grilled or roasted red meats, game, and strong tasty cheeses, such as Parmesan.

## Pinot Noir Barda 2007 Patagonia - Sassicaia

**\$ 15 gl**



While subtle, this is very complex with a faintly sweet edge to the medicinal herb notes and lovely insinuations of cigarette ash and limestone that gives this real finesse on the nose. Pure, light red fruits dance across the palate.

## Vino Nobile di Montepulciano - 2005 - Poliziano

**\$ 15 gl**

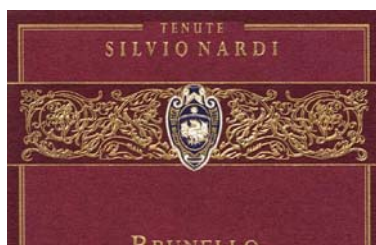


The 2005 Vino Nobile di Montepulciano is a medium-bodied offering with sweet dark fruit, spices and toasted oak. It appears to be somewhat forward but there is enough plumpness to suggest a few years of pleasurable drinking.

## Brunello di Montalcino 2004 - Nardi

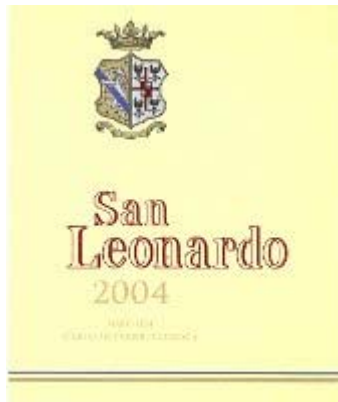

Deep ruby in color with purple highlights, this wine shows an intense bouquet of red berries offset by notes of leather and incense which are confirmed on the palate, supported by firm, elegant tannins of moderate intensity.

**San Leonardo 2004 - Cab, C. Franc, Merlot - Trentino      \$ 18 gl**



San Leonardo shows a brilliant ruby red color and nuances of ruby red, little transparency. The nose reveals intense, clean, pleasing, refined and elegant aromas which start with hints of black currant, black cherry and plum followed by aromas of violet, blueberry, vanilla, tobacco, bell pepper, raspberry, pink pepper, cocoa, cinnamon and eucalyptus. The mouth has excellent correspondence to the nose, a tannic attack and however balanced by alcohol, full body, intense flavors, pleasing roundness. The finish is very persistent with long flavors of black currant, black cherry and plum.

**Barolo 2004 - Michele Chiarlo      \$ 19 gl**



Very fresh on the nose, with sliced plums and hints of blackberries. Full-bodied, with a solid core of ripe yet clean fruit and very silky tannins. Very polished. Refined, high toned red currant and berry flavors and aromas mark this balanced, elegant wine and lead into suggestions of violets, rose petals, spice and leather set in finely delineated tannins. 91/100 - Wine Spectator

**Castello Ginori 2004 - Merlot, Cab - Tuscany      \$ 18 gl**



A fully welcoming, warmth-laden nose that envelopes you in a cloak of crushed blackberry/bramble, coffee and herbed dried cherry. An inviting entry of cherry dusted with cedar and white truffle leads through to elegant flavours of forest berry, high-toned pie cherry, white pepper and lashings of cassis liqueur. Beautiful and delicious elegance that is wrapped in depth and broad tannins at the mid- and back palate. Finishes balanced and prompts you to keep drinking it.

## Fontalloro 2005 - Sangiovese - Felsina - Tuscany

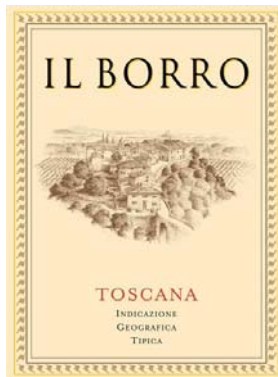
Exhibits pure raspberry and strawberry on the nose. Full-bodied, with an enticing core of fruit and a long, silky-textured finish

## Pinot Noir Reserve Russian River 2007 - Martin Ray

**\$ 20 gl**

A lovely Pinot Noir, lightly delicate and elegantly silky, yet with powerhouse flavors that impress. Floods the palate with wild red cherry, cola, sandalwood and cinnamon spice flavors, excited with clean acidity.

## Il Borro 2006 - Merlot, Cab. &amp; Syrah - Ferragamo

**\$ 15 gl**

'Il Borro' is a deep ruby red with dark purple reflections and has an intense bouquet of ripe fruit with notes of forest underbrush and spice. It is a dry, round and well-balanced wine with soft rich tannins that are consistent creating great length of finish. It pairs nicely with roasted meats, stews and seasonal cheeses.
